Attached for filing electronically with the Commission is Supplement No. 61 to the Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 12-GAS, issued by The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid New York (the “Company” or “National Grid”) to become effective August 24, 2012.

Following consultation with Department of Public Service Staff (“Staff”), National Grid is filing to postpone until November 1, 2012, the effective date of the tariff leaves previously filed that provided for new communications protocols for the Company’s non-firm customers. After discussions with Staff, it was deemed necessary to extend the effective date of these leaves.

The Company respectfully requests that this supplement go into effect on short notice on or before August 1, 2012.
