## Economic Incentive Rate Statement

A customer receiving an Economic Development Incentive (EDI) or Economic Development Zone Incentive (EDZI) for kilowatt-hour (kWh) usage attributable to load qualified on or after July 1, 2003, or a customer receiving an Incremental Load Incentive (ILI), will have its service bills reduced by the following incentive rate per kWh, for all qualified kWhs:

**Service Classification Nos. 2, 3, or 7 -- EDI Load:**

NYSEG Fixed Price Option (FPO)	\$0.0047
ESCO Price Option (EPO) or NYSEG Variable Price Option (VPO) or Hourly Pricing	\$0.0047

**Service Classification Nos. 2, 3, or 7 – EDZI or ILI\* Load:**

Supply Service Option	Incentive Rate, per kWh
NYSEG Fixed Price Option (FPO)	\$0.0047
ESCO Price Option (EPO) or NYSEG Variable Price Option (VPO) or Hourly Pricing	\$0.0047

\* Note, SC2 ILI customers will receive a \$2.00 per kW Demand credit on all qualified kilowatts (kW) in addition to the Incentive Rate per kWh specified above.
