SECTION 23 – PRIMEREACH SERVICE

23.1 Description

PrimeReach Service is offered to certified Local Exchange Carrier customers for the purpose of originating and terminating calls between regions within LATA 132 as described in NYNEX Tariff P.S.C. 900. PrimeReach Service may be accessed either by presubscription or by casual dialing. For the purposes of this tariff, casual dialing refers to the ability of an end user to use 10XXXX to access PrimeReach Service. The Company reserves the right to reject any customer request for PrimeReach Service.

23.2 Timing of Calls

- a. Unless otherwise indicated, all calls are timed in 60 second initial and 6 second additional increments.
- b. For station to station calls, call timing begins when a connection is established between the calling telephone and the called telephone station.
- c. Call timing ends when the calling station "hangs up", thereby releasing the network connection. If the called station "hangs up" but the calling station does not, chargeable time ends when the network connection is released either by automatic timing equipment in the telephone network or by the Company.
- d. Calls originating in one time period as defined in Section 9 and terminating in another will be billed the rates in effect at the beginning of each minute.

23.3 Time Periods Defined

All time periods found in Section 9 apply to PrimeReach Service.

23.4 Rate Regulations

Rates for PrimeReach service are based on whether an inter-region call is placed to an adjacent or non-adjacent region of LATA 132 as defined in NYNEX Tariff P.S.C.900. In addition, rates are dependent on the time of day in which a PrimeReach call is made.
