SECTION 7 - RECIPROCAL COMPENSATION ARRANGEMENTS

7.1 GENERAL

Reciprocal Compensation Arrangements are available to Other Network Providers ("ONP's") who are also certified providers of local exchange service. Under a Reciprocal Compensation Arrangement, the Company compensates the ONP for Company traffic terminating on the ONP's network and the ONP compensates the Company for ONP traffic terminating on the Company's network.

Compensation for terminating local traffic can be determined through reciprocal compensation agreements or by local call termination rates filed in this tariff, subject to the provisions of the Commission's Order in Case 94-C-0095, "Order Instituting Framework For Directory Listings, Carrier Interconnection And Intercarrier Compensation." Issued and Effective September 27, 1995.

7.2 Bill and Keep Arrangements are available to Other Network Providers, (ONP's) who are also certified providers of local exchange service. Under a Bill and Keep Arrangement, the Company does not compensate the ONP for Company traffic terminating on the ONP's network and the ONP does not compensate the Company compensate for ONP traffic terminating on the Company's network.

Compensation of this nature for terminating local traffic can be determined through reciprocal compensation agreements/interconnection agreements or by local call termination rates filed in this tariff, subject to the provisions of the Commission's Order in Case 94-C-0095, "Order Instituting Framework For Directory Listings, Carrier Interconnection and Intercarrier Compensation." Issued and Effective September 27, 1995

7.3 MEASUREMENT OF ACCESS MINUTES AND DETERMINATION OF BALANCE

The Company and Other Network Providers will measure, on a monthly basis, the originating and terminating local usage.
