Description

Asymmetrical Digital Subscriber Line (ADSL) Service provides a customer with high speed Internet access in one of two configurations. ADSL is available either 768 kbps upstream and 128 kbps downstream or 1.5 Mbps upstream and 512 kbps downstream. This service is provisioned on ILEC-provided unbundled network elements (UNEs) and is currently available as facilities permit. Performance of the transmission speeds in dependant on various factors including the distance of the customer's location from the central office and the quality of the UNE provided by the ILEC. It is the customer's responsibility to secure the ISP connectivity that is required for this service. A separate service charge will apply if a customer chooses to downgrade their service from the next higher speed.
